National Film Preservation Foundation (52-2055624) Form 990, Page 2, Part III Statement of Program Accomplishments

The National Film Preservation Foundation is a nonprofit organization created by the U.S. Congress to preserve and to make publicly accessible our nation's film heritage. Its programs preserve American films that would be unlikely to survive without public support, improve film access for education and exhibition, and encourage public commitment to preserving film as an art form, historical record, and cultural resource.

The Foundation (1) gives film preservation grants to archives, historical societies, libraries, museums, and universities, and (2) organizes, secures funding for, and manages collaborative preservation and access projects that enable film institutions to work together on national initiatives. Since starting operations in 1997, it has provided preservation support to over 130 institutions across 37 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico and helped to save more than 850 films.

The Foundation receives the majority of its revenues from contributions of cash and donated services from individuals, corporations, and foundations, DVD sales, program service fees, and government funding.

Program highlights of 2005 include:

- Awarded preservation grants to 46 archives, libraries, and museums, totaling \$300,000 in cash and \$80,000 in in-kind preservation services.
- Received the Society of American Archivists' Preservation Publication Award for The Film Preservation Guide: The Basics for Archives, Libraries, and Museums (2004). This award recognizes a work of "superior excellence and usefulness, which advances the theory or practice of preservation in archival institutions." The NFPF has distributed 2,000 printed copies and makes the text available for free downloading. The primer has been translated into Farsi; Chinese and Korean translations are underway.
- Produced the Encore Edition of Treasures from American Film Archives, 50
 Preserved Films. When originally issued in 2000, this award-winning four-disc
 DVD box set was the first to showcase the range of orphan films saved by public
 and nonprofit archives. The net proceeds from the reissue were shared with
 contributing archives.
- Began Treasures III, a three-DVD set of silent-era films exploring social issues from different ideological perspectives. The anthology will draw from the preservation work of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, George Eastman House, the Library of Congress, the Museum of Modern Art, the National Archives, and the UCLA Film & Television Archive. The National Film Preservation Board provided the seed money to start production.

- Secured funding and started work on *Industrial and Institutional Films: A Field Guide,* an annotated filmography of 500 culturally and historically significant films sponsored by business, advocacy, and charitable groups over the last century. The new reference tool, written by Rick Prelinger with the collaboration of archivists and scholars, will create a roadmap to a relatively uncharted area of American film production. The project is funded by The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation. The field guide will be published in late 2006.
- Received awards from the National Society of Film Critics and II Cinema Ritrovato in Bologna, Italy, for *More Treasures from American Film Archives*, 1894-1931, the NFPF's three-DVD set with book issued in 2004.
