*Additional information regarding grants reported in Part 2: In 2014, the NFPF gave the New Zealand Film Archive new film prints created as part of a collaborative project to repatriate and preserve American silent-era films found in the archive's vaults and began a similar collaborative project with EYE Filmmuseum Netherlands. Through the former multi-year initiative, the NZFA has given the American archival community 176 films. In most cases, the NFPF provides the NZFA a print of each complete film at the NFPF's own expense. This past year the laboratory work for all of the NFPF supported films was performed in the United States. The cost for returning the resulting viewing copies to New Zealand is not borne by the NFPF. For more about the New Zealand project, please see the NFPF website, http://www.filmpreservation.org/preserved-films/new-zealand-project-films-highlights A three-year initiative with EYE Filmmuseum Netherlands was begun. So far 26 American silent films have been returned to the US for preservation. A grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities will facilitate the preservation of nonfiction films found in the EYE collection.
